



**LATRICE MILLER**

At 12:40 p.m. on October 28, 1990 Latrice Nicole Miller, a 15 year old female, was found dead next to Haikey Creek under a bridge at 9100 S. Mingo Road. The victim was discovered by a ten year old boy, who was walking to a friend's house. One witness described a mid-70s, 2-door, Oldsmobile or Pontiac, beige or cream, parked at the bridge on October 26, 1990 at about 6:00 to 7:00 P.M... Another witness described a dark, 78-79 Camaro driving slowly and parking on the bridge at 11:00-11:15 P.M. on October 27, 1990.



**LISA HENDERSON**

On Friday June 1, 1979, 17-year old Lisa Ann Henderson left her residence at 7929 South 70<sup>th</sup> E. Pl. She told her brother she was going to see about a "modeling" job. When Lisa had not returned home by 5:00 p.m. that day her family became worried. They contacted her friends and co-workers but no one had seen or heard from her that day. A neighbor recalled seeing Lisa leave around noon that day carrying a plastic garment bag with several items inside. The witness described the vehicle that she left in as a 1976-77 maroon Chevrolet Monte Carlo with no hubcaps and damage to the driver's side. The driver was a white male, approximately 40 years old, with dark thinning hair. This was the last time anyone saw Lisa alive. Henderson's body was found on June 11, 1979 in Wagoner County.



**CHRISTIE WARD**

The body of Christie Ward was found off the side of the road at approximately 13800 E. 51<sup>st</sup> Street, on Sunday, September 4, 1988, at 1130 hours. She was found by two 13-year old boys looking for a pond to fish in. Ward was found partially clothed with her hands tied behind her back. The ensuing investigation revealed that Ward had been reported as a Missing Person on September 3, 1988 at 1914 hours. The victim was reported to be missing from her residence at 5936 S. 87 E. Avenue. Also reported missing was the victim's car, which was a red, 1987 Pontiac Firebird. Her vehicle was discovered near her residence.



**LISA GASKIN**

At 11:00 P.M. on March 27, 2000 Lisa Gaskin went to see her stepfather at his place of employment. The victim was walking and left in the direction to head back to her friend's home in Oakhurst. On March 28, 2000 at 1:37 A.M. Gaskin's body was discovered along the railroad tracks at 4200 Southwest Blvd. The victim was seen by a witness walking with an unknown male. The witness then heard the sounds of a struggle and observed the victim being beaten and then thrown into a ditch alongside the railroad tracks.



**MELISSA MOORE**

On March 25, 1984 at approximately 12:50 a.m. Melissa Ann Moore left the Tulsa University Chi Omega house and returned to her residence at 232 Montclair Avenue. On Wednesday, April 17, 1984, Melissa Moore's body was found in Pryor Creek off Highway 20 and 460 Road in Mayes County.



**LAVERNE**

**NORMAN** Laverne Etta Norman lived alone in a one-bedroom apartment. On Monday, February 10, 1992 a co-worker, who was worried about the victim because she did not show up for work, went to the victim's apartment to check on her and discovered the Victim. Ms. Norman had last been seen alive on Saturday, February 7, 1992, at 1630 hours, when she left her beautician job at the 61<sup>st</sup> Street Beauty Salon.

**CANDYCE WOODWARD**

Candyce R Woodward was 38 years old and lived in a duplex located at 3902 S. 125<sup>th</sup> East Avenue. On Wednesday January 7, 1987 she took her son to school at approximately 8:40 A.M. and returned home to babysit a neighbor's 3 year old daughter.

At approximately 2:30 P.M. the victim's husband reportedly came home and discovered the victim dead in her bedroom. The 3-year old child was in the living room and was unharmed. Woodward died of blunt trauma type injuries.



**ROBERT PHILLIPS  
DAVID PHILLIPS**

On Monday, December 7, 1992, at approximately 8:45 P.M. the parents of Robert, 26 years old, and David, 19 years old, returned to their single-family residence located at 9817 S. Oswego Avenue after an evening of Christmas shopping. When they entered the residence, they discovered both of their sons dead inside. Robert died of blunt trauma, David from a gunshot wound.



**EMMA GOODOU**

On Saturday morning, July 30, 1994 Emma Jean Goodou was discovered deceased in the kitchen of her rented single-family residence at 820 East 51 Place North. She was found by her daughter and sister who went to check on her after the she did not answer her telephone. Goodou had sustained numerous stab wounds and blunt trauma to her body.



**LATRICIA FIPPS**

Latricia Diane Fipps was last seen on November 21, 2002 at 212 South Phoenix Avenue getting into Joe Calvert's vehicle. Calvert was her ex-boyfriend at the time. The investigation has indicated Fipps met with foul play, however her body has never been found



**ROBERTINA HELLMAN**

At approximately 1:35 P.M., May 14, 1991, Robertina Inez Hellman, 18 years old, was found dead in the bathroom of her apartment in the Eagle Point complex, 5826 E. 71<sup>st</sup> Pl., apt #1205. The apartment manager found the victim in the bathtub filled with water. Her death was ruled a Homicide.



**VICKIE HILL**

Vickie Marie Hill was a married 23-year old who lived with her husband at the Westport Apartment Complex, 1551 Southwest Blvd. Her husband worked the evening shift. When he arrived home from work, at approximately 2:00 A.M. on September 5, 1984, he discovered the victim dead in the floor of the apartment's living room. She died from stab wounds.



**MARILYN BASE**

Marilyn Joi Base was separated from her husband and living with her boyfriend. On April 9, 1987 at 9:00 P.M. she left her shared apartment to drive to the complex's laundry room. Her vehicle was found with the keys still in the ignition, parked just outside of the laundry room and her clothes still in the dryer. Her body was discovered on Braggs Mountain in Muskogee County at 10:05 A.M. on April 19, 1987.



**JAMES GARRETT**

On September 10, 1995 James Lamont Garrett was found deceased at 1819 W. Independence. Garrett died from a gunshot wound.
